The Basque Society of Watercolorists (Agrupación Vasca de Acuarelistas – AVA) takes over from the German Watercolor Society and will be in charge of organizing in 2022, in the city of Bilbao, the 25th edition of the International Watercolor Symposium to which we are pleased to invite all the ECWS member-societies.

Our Society, with 77 years of trajectory, since it was founded in 1945, organized the Symposium of 2006 and the gained experience is being the main baggage to carry out this next Symposium where watercolor will be the protagonist.

Bilbao has very favorable characteristics to host an event like this, since it is a medium-sized city with very special scenery provided by its long history and culture. It preserves its Old Town and has a modern city expansion area, being the interaction of both what gives this unique character to the city. It is very comfortable and easy to go all over, it is crossed by an estuary with an industrial background that has been reinvented as the main artery of the city.

Our city has made a strong commitment to art and culture and has a network of very interesting museums, among which we want to highlight the emblematic Guggenheim and the Museum of Fine Arts.

Using these signs of identity and this cultural background, we have developed the Symposium program.

In Bilbao, during the last 20 years, buildings for cultural purposes have been regenerated, spaces have been created for activities that promote the quality of life and projects that support the work of local artists and entities, have increased. Among them is our Basque Society of Watercolourists, the AVA. We are lucky to have two wonderful exhibition spaces provided by the institutions, *Bizkaia Aretoa* of the UPV-EHU (<u>Bizkaia Aretoa</u>) and Ondare of the Provincial Council of Bizkaia. (<u>Ondare Hall</u>)

During the days the Symposium lasts, we will turn into our visitors so that they can enjoy this passion that unites us, and which we show the world with events like this. The sponsors, Goya Bellas Artes and Winsor&Newton, and the collaborators, Escoda and Artemiranda, with their contributions of materials, gifts and others, will put the finishing touch to our scheduled activities.



SYMPOSIUM ACTIVITIES

Arrival in Bilbao

To arrive to Bilbao there is a good communications network. Loiu airport is about 15 minutes away by bus or taxi. There is a connection to the center with the A3247 Bilbao-Airport line.

The compact nature of Bilbao makes moving around the city easy and accessible, it has one of the best metro networks, frequent buses, trains and trams that interconnect the key areas of Bilbao with each other, and with the coast and the surroundings.

Bilbao is located between mountains, with the estuary as the main axis, urbanistically it has ideal characteristics for the enjoyment of the visiting artist, both for the narrow streets of the old town and for the wide spaces offered by the most modern city. We can even paint an aerial view of the city by going up in the classic funicular of Artxanda, a place that for the people of Bilbao is the lung of the city. (<u>Funicular</u>)



Registration

The *Castaños Civic Center* on Castaños street nº11, on the right bank of the estuary, is an historic modernist building from 1910, which was an old public wash house and today acts as a municipal services center. Accreditations for the symposium will be collected there from Monday 26 in the afternoon until Wednesday 28 (the specific schedules appear below in the document). Each participant will receive a welcome package: symposium program, city map, gifts from sponsors and collaborators.

Important: The Winsor & Newton watercolor papers that must be used in the scheduled watercolor contests will be provided with the accreditation and stamped by the Organization.



AVA exhibition

It will take place in SALA ONDARE. María Díaz de Haro nº11 BILBAO (Ondare Hall)

The ONDARE hall belongs to the Bizkaia Provincial Council it has 400 m² of exhibition space and is located on the ground floor of the Bizkaia Provincial Archive.

Guided visits to the exhibition: It will be on Monday 26 and Tuesday 27 at 19:00h.

The AVA exhibition can be visited prior to the opening of the symposium. From 07/20/22 to 10/15/22.





International watercolor exhibition - Opening ceremony

It will take place in the Bizkaia Aretoa Building, on Thursday, September 29 at 7:00 p.m. after the master class performed in the same building (Avenida Abandoibarra, 3) (Bizkaia Aretoa).

The opening will be accompanied by refreshments. If the weather allows it, we will be able to access the terrace, where the amazing views will be the ideal complement for that moment of fraternity, share impressions about the works, reunions, toast...

It will be exhibited in Vitoria-Gasteiz at the School of Arts and Crafts (<u>School</u>) and will finally be shown in Gipuzkoa at the Irún House of Culture (<u>Amaia KZ</u>), ending on 11/11/22.

Contests

Two kinds of contests will be held, the plein-air WATERCOLOR and the BILBAO sketch. Only those registered for the symposium will be able to participate.

As informed above, the watercolour paper for the two contests will be provided at the time of collecting the Symposium accreditation, at the Castaños Civic Center located at Castaños street nº11, at the times established in the program that is attached to this document.

Plein air Watercolor contest

It will be held throughout the morning of Saturday, October 1st. From 9:00 to 10:00 a.m., the second stamping of the paper (which was previously delivered with the accreditation to the symposium) will take place at the Hotel Conde Duque located in Campo Volantín nº22. Once the works are finished, they will be delivered at the same place, before 2:00 p.m.

The works will be exhibited in the *smoking room* of the Sociedad Bilbaína (Navarra street nº1) in the afternoon since 7:00 p.m. The awards ceremony will take place during the Gala Dinner, which will be held at the same building.





BILBAO sketch contest

The artists will carry out their work throughout the week on the stamped paper delivered at the time of accreditation. The subject will be BILBAO. In this case the paper should not be stamped a

The delivery of the work performed for the contest will take place on Saturday, October 1st at the Conde Duque Hotel located in Campo Volantín nº22 from 9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.

The works will be exhibited in the smoking room of the Sociedad Bilbaína (Navarra street nº1) in the afternoon since 7:00 p.m. The awards ceremony will take place during the Gala Dinner, which will be held at the same building.
